- Guide Analysts in completing the client due diligence checks against proposed or existing clients and thirdparty payors in-line with regulatory standards and firm policy.
- Ensure the correct analysis is being applied to client and matter risk assessments.
- Advise on queries regarding third-party payors liaising with the Finance team when necessary.
- Assist the Analysts in escalations before they reach the Director of AML Compliance, Deputy MLRO's or MLRO's, including providing a walkthrough of any issues and a proposal as to whether a matter should be approved, rejected or if further information is needed.
- Oversee the management of the AML Compliance team Inbox.
- Horizon scan and escalate the Firm's AML policy, control and/ or procedural changes to the Director of AML Compliance for discussion and review.
- Support the Director of AML Compliance in conducting regular training for the AML Compliance Team to ensure the team are up to date with applicable AML laws and regulations with guidance

- Strong analytical skills and working knowledge and ability to use Compliance systems e.g., Intapp, Orbis, D&B, World Compliance or equivalent and 3E or equivalent.

- Co-ordinate, manage and assist in delivering the AML training plan for the AML Compliance Team, Lawyers, and Support Staff.
- Conduct quality assurance checks to ensure any system, process or procedural issues are identified and corrected with the AML Compliance Analyst or Team and escalate to the Director of AML Compliance for review.
- Assist in the completion of the regulatory questionnaires and returns for the DFSA and ADGM in the UAE.
- Provide support during regulatory audits and internal audits.
- Assist Partners and the Director of AML Compliance to make suspicious activity reports to the NCA or relevant body.
- Support and assist with AML Compliance related complex projects and strategic objectives as identified by the Director of AML Compliance.
- Support and aid the continuous development and review of AML Compliance software deployed by the department.
- Be actively part of the change management culture within the AML Compliance team and out towards the Firm's support functions, Lawyers and Partners.
- Provide AML advice and manage relationships with key internal stakeholder: Partners, Lawyers, Secretaries, Compliance Team, Conflicts Team, MLROs, Finance and IT.
